The Marching Knights Band will be competing at the LA County Fair in their “Battle of the Bands” Competition. Students will spend the afternoon at the fair, then march that evening. Details are as follows:

Bus Leaves:	10:00 am
Meeting Place:	Band Room (O102) at 9:50 am
Parade Starts:	5:30 pm
Pickup at:	8:15 pm at AAE
Wear:	AAE school pants or Jeans, Marching Knights T-shirt & Jacket
BRING:	<u>Marching Uniforms (complete with shoes)</u>
Marches:	Thunderer and Matrix (MEMORIZED!!!)

BRING SOMETHING TO EAT/DRINK FOR DINNER!!

1. There’s not much room on the bus SO bring dinner in a brown paper bag. Make sure your food and drinks are in disposable containers and do not need to be in a cooler. Label your dinner clearly with your name.
2. Students will NOT have an opportunity to buy food or drinks after the parade. They WILL, however, have an opportunity to buy lunch.
3. Parents who would like to ride on the bus should contact me ASAP as space is VERY limited. We NEED several parents who have been pre-approved to chaperone!!
4. Students will have about 4 hours to look around the fair. Things are VERY expensive there. Spending money is optional.
5. If you do not wish your student to ride the bus to the fair, you will be responsible for getting them IN UNIFORM, with their instrument, to the fair no later than 4:00 pm that day! This parade, like all of our performances, counts as a grade!
6. We will also need to know of any students that are not riding back on the bus. Students can ONLY be released to parents/guardians.

Apple Valley Round-Up Days Parade Saturday, September 8

Meet at: 7:45 am. Do NOT be late!!

Meeting Place: Around Shawnee & Niabi Rd (*See map below*) **Look for us!!**

Parade Starts: 9:00 am

Pickup at: 10:00 am @ Pawnee & Powhatten, Ballfield #4 at the Community Center. Parents can park here and meet Band members after the parade.

Wear: Marching Uniforms (black shoes/ white gloves).

Marches: Matrix and Thunderer (Memorized)

Details: Parade runs west from Central to Pawnee (about 1 mile). Judges stand is the corner of John Glenn Rd. An additional announcer's stand is at *Mollie's Kountry Kitchen* (Delmar Road.) Please AVOID Hiway 18. It will close around 7:00 am. *Awards will be given out at 2:00 pm at Horseman's Center. Admission is free.*

IMPORTANT: Meet at the parade site, NOT the school!
